


## HEAD TO HEAD COMPARISON

- Designed for carbide teeth
  - » Withstands impact and abrasion
- Faster in smaller material less than 6"
- Less maintenance, lower operating cost
  - » Rental applications or hired operators
- Grinds stumps below grade or flush with the ground
- Incorporating mulch into the ground
  - » Rocky terrain
- Right of way maintenance



Larger opening allows teeth to pull in whole limbs, creating mulch inside the processing chamber

- Designed for sharp teeth
  - » Ideal for mulching wood with minimal ground contact
- Faster in big wood greater than 6"
- Sharpen/replace steel teeth
- Mulching large trees
  - » Potential fire hazard in thick duff
  - » Hard on fibrous wood
- More efficient use of available power



Closed throat pushes larger material into teeth, creating mulch in front and inside processing chamber
